

SAR Social Runs to Continue Through Summer

The new SAR social runs Downtown have proven to be a big hit, with over 2,000 discrete participants at the weekly Meet Me At Maynard's runs and walks. Every Monday night at 6:00, some 200 folks come to the new restaurant at the old train depot at 400 North Toole Street and run or walk 3 or so miles throughout the streets of Tucson. Come early or late, and walk or run at your pace and distance. Sign-in will open at 5:30 and close at 7:00.



Come 5 times and get a free hat. Do 8 and get a free t-shirt, courtesy of TEP!



Routes vary, with the newest iteration taking in the new and improved Scott Street. Come August, the route will incorporate the new Fourth Avenue Underpass. Those looking for more than three miles normally head east along Broadway and do a nice little loop that include the Basket Bridge, Rattlesnake Bridge and the Lost Barrio.



Parking is available southeast of Hotel Congress, and west of the Train Depot. Plus, there is no need to feed parking meters on the street after 5:00 PM.



This is a weekly social event for vibrant active people who are building community in downtown Tucson – enjoy civic networking, discounted dining, and a social way to get in shape.
